#### 1. Gardens

Residents can water their gardens with a bucket, filled directly from a tap, on any weekday between 4pm and 8am. On the weekends, you can use a hose fitted with a twist or trigger nozzle. Refer to the table below for watering times.

If you have an aged, disability or other approved medical concession\*, you can also water twice a week for half an hour.
